Activity Report:- Under the chairmanship of S.J. Gopabandhy Mishra, the departmental seminar was conducted by Dr. Manojkumar Dash as a resource person. After seminar 08 numbers of students presented their paper on the topic. Remaining students and staff members of the department kept their opinion on the topic.

Abstract:- The civil disobedience movement in Balasore District deeply influenced the politics of Nalgonda. This princely state was situated in the Eastern side of the Balasore District. In this movement a number of people from Nalgonda had participated. Gradually, the people of this princely state got undelighted and opposed illegal collection tax like Betha, Begar, Magan and Sukar. In order to further compound the opposition, "A Yuba Sukha Samiti" was formed at Asodhya to provide a platform against the autocratic rule of Raja. Due to Gandhian movement in Balasore District, the democratic movement proliferated in Balasore District. After the formation of Congress ministry of 1937 in Odisha, the Congress took active participation in Nalgonda affairs. The fulfillment of demands raised the confidence of the popular struggle. The most significant contribution of civil disobedience movement was the germination of popular movement in Nalgonda which led to the strengthening of the movement and amalgamation of Nalgonda in 1948 with Union of India.
